



Facts: UT Health San Antonio Multispecialty and Research Hospital

- Eight-story, 144-bed hospital to offer specialty care in cancer, orthopaedics, urology, and thoracic and bariatric surgery
- Early phase clinical trials, including immunologic and stem cell therapies for cancer, supported by the most innovative research being conducted across South Texas
- Connected by a sky bridge to the Mays Cancer Center, one of only four National Cancer Institute-designated cancer centers in Texas and home to UT Health San Antonio MD Anderson
- 12 operating rooms, intensive care unit, infusion center, emergency department, pharmacy, laboratories and imaging center
- Offering the expertise of 900 faculty specialists and subspecialists to serve patients
- First-in-class new hospital will add 100 medical residents and fellows and bring 800 high-quality jobs to the city
- On 12.2 acres at 8311 Ewing Halsell Drive in the South Texas Medical Center; land donated by the San Antonio Medical Foundation
- Construction to be completed in the fall of 2024
- Cost: \$430 million
- Gross square feet: 448,819
- Parking: Seven-story, 673-car parking garage and 200-car surface lot
