

UT Health San Antonio Multispecialty and Research Hospital Facts and Figures



- » On 12.2 acres at 8311 Ewing Halsell Drive in the South Texas Medical Center; land donated by the San Antonio Medical Foundation.
- » Eight-story, 144-bed hospital to offer complex specialty care in cancer, orthopaedics and sports medicine, urology, spinal surgery, vascular surgery and bariatrics.
- » Early-phase clinical trials supported by the most innovative research being conducted across South Texas.
- » Immunologic and stem cell therapies for cancer.

- » Connected by a sky bridge to the Mays Cancer Center, one of only four National Cancer Institute-designated cancer centers in Texas and home to UT Health San Antonio MD Anderson Cancer Center.
- » 12 operating rooms, interventional radiology, intensive care unit, emergency department, pharmacy, laboratories and imaging center.
- » Offering the expertise of 900 faculty specialists and subspecialists to serve patients.
- » First-in-class new hospital adding hundreds of medical trainees including medical residents and fellows, advance-practice providers and nursing students, and bringing 800 high-quality jobs to the city.



- » Construction completion expected by late fall of 2024.
- » Cost: \$472 million.
- » Parking: Seven-story, 673-car parking garage and 200-car surface lot.
- » Architect/engineer: EYP.
- » Construction manager-at-risk: Vaughn Construction.
